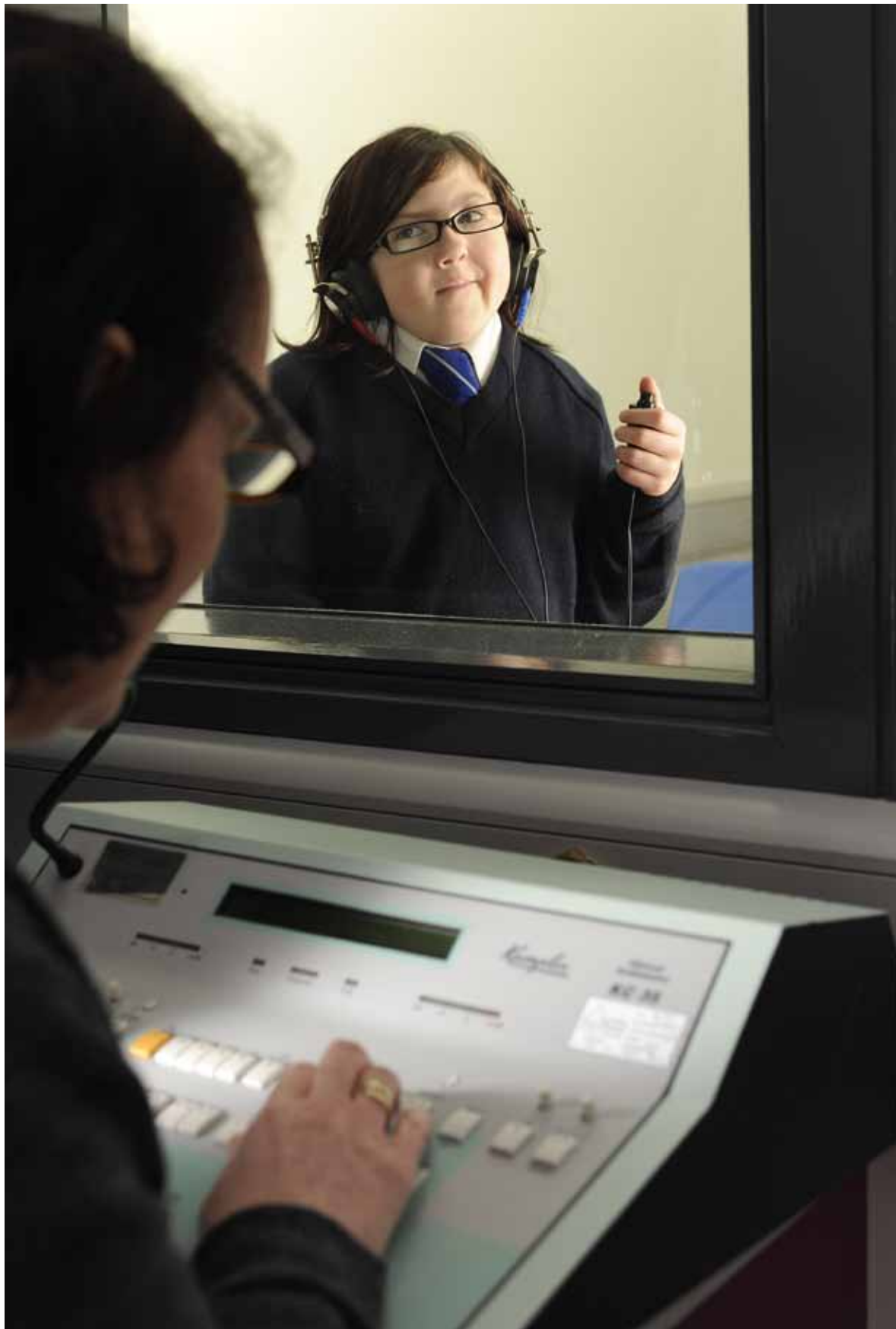

Our diverse team of teachers and classroom assistants use Total Communication, Sign Supported English, BSL, FM and Soundfield Systems, Moon, Braille, closed circuit electronic magnification tools and large print formats to engage and educate both in and outside of the classroom.





In addition to being a specialist learning environment, Jordanstown is also equipped with the latest testing and therapy facilities. Used by medical professionals from local Health Care Trusts, it offers children and their parents a simpler, easier and more comfortable way to access medical and therapy input, reducing unnecessary time spent away from the classroom. These facilities include a brand new hydrotherapy pool, therapy rooms and training rooms. Our highly trained staff members are also able to offer training and guidance in our residential facilities for parents and families to help ensure a relaxed home life for everyone.

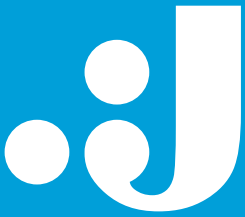
